TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SKIP HIRE SERVICES

- **NO** fridges, freezers, mattresses, batteries, fuel tanks, tyres, toxic waste, paint, computer monitors, television sets, gas cylinders/bottles. Such waste will be refused or subject to a surcharge.
- **NO** Asbestos. Asbestos can only be disposed of in a skip with prior notification and authority from the Environment Agency; this includes the disposal of cement bonded sheet asbestos. Skips containing unauthorised asbestos will be charged at the current rate for the complete load.
- Waste Electronic and Electrical Equipment (WEEE) **must** be kept separate from other waste
- Plasterboard and all gypsum based materials **must** be separated from general waste.
- The hirer maintains responsibility for **all** materials placed in the skip.
- Skips **must not** be loaded above the top of the skip. Materials must not be used to increase the size of the skip. Drivers may **refuse** to collect an overloaded skip or may unload any surplus. Additional charges for this will be the liability of the hirer.
- Strictly **no** fires, any damage caused as a result of a fire will be the liability of the hirer.
- Strictly **no** hazardous ash residue. Incinerator bottom ash or any residue arising from burning waste **must** be disposed of via a specialist hazardous waste carrier.
- The time allowed for deposition, or collection of a skip is **20 minutes**. If the vehicle is kept waiting any longer than this after arrival, the hirer may be liable for any waiting time incurred.
- If the skip is to be placed on the highway, Bucks Recycling Ltd will arrange appropriate permits. The provision and maintenance of warning signs and/or lights is **by law** the hirer's responsibility.
- Bucks Recycling Ltd accept **no** responsibility for any damage caused to any property or services above or below ground following the customer's request for us to enter property. The customer is also responsible for any damage incurred to vehicles and skips.
- It is the hirer's responsibility to protect driveways by using wooden planks as bearers for the skip.
- Skips should be available for collection within **14 days** of delivery for non-account customers or hire charges may apply.
- **Do not** reposition skips after delivery as this can make the removal of the skip awkward and may result in damage when lifting the full skip.
